Size and Scope

- Over the last three years, Delta and Northwest combined have added more than 100 new international routes while increasing passenger unit revenues.
- Delta is the world's largest carrier. It is #1 across the Atlantic, #1 U.S. carrier to Asia; #2 to Latin America and the Caribbean, and the only U.S. carrier with scheduled service to Africa.
- Delta and Northwest's international growth is supported by its broad domestic feeder network which serves the most domestic U.S. destinations of any airline.

Trans-Atlantic Service

- Combined, Delta-Northwest is the world's leading carrier between the United States and trans-Atlantic destinations, ranking #1 in departures, destinations and available seat miles (ASMs).
- The carrier added new international routes in 2009, including New York-JFK to Abuja, Nigeria (via Dakar, Senegal); Tokyo, Japan; Valencia, Spain; Prague, Czech Republic; Zurich, Switzerland. Also added service between Tokyo and Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam; Pittsburgh and Paris; and Detroit to Shanghai, China.
